

Veterans Day Parade: ORDER OF MARCH

PARADE VEHICLE MARKINGS AND IDENTIFICATION: To assist passage through Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department (IMPD) barricades and assist parade marshals, please ensure that all parade vehicles in your entry are appropriately labeled. If a vehicle was indicated on the registration form, a PARADE VEHICLE ACCESS PASS is included. Please print one pass per vehicle in your entry and ensure your TEAM (DIVISION) number and UNIT NUMBER (Order of Go) (i.e., 1-18,) is identified on the pass – PLEASE USE A THICK BLACK MARKER SO THE ENTRY NUMBER IS VISIBLE. This pass will aid the marshals in your placement during lineup. This pass must be taped to the inside of the windshield on the PASSENGER SIDE of the vehicle for visibility to the parade marshal.
